### **How Do I Pick Up My Ambassador Pass?**

Pick up your Pass at the Community Services Desk at Banff Town Hall at 110 Bear St once you've completed the experience you registered for. You are eligible to receive only one Ambassador Pass.

### **What Do I Need To Bring To Pick Up My Ambassador Pass?**

- Proof of employment in Banff, Lake Louise or other parts of Banff National Park
- Attendance confirmation email from the Welcome & Orientation session that you attended.
- Personal identification

The Community Services team will check that you joined a BanffLIFE Mountain Adventure Program or a MountainLIFE adventure and then issue your Ambassador Pass.
