#### INTERPRETIVE SIGHTSEEING TOUR

Experience your choice of interpretive sightseeing tours and enjoy getting out to learn more about the destination! Part Two is an interpretive sightseeing tour offered by both Discover Banff Tours and Brewster Sightseeing, during which you will visit some of the iconic sites of the destination and learn more about its natural wonders and history. You are welcome to participate in all of the following sightseeing options. Upon completion of your sightseeing tour, you may progress to Part Three and pick up your Ambassador Pass. Please note that only one Ambassador Pass will be issued per eligible participant.

#### What Do I Need To Participate?

- o Proof of your employment in Banff, Lake Louise or other parts of Banff National Park
- o Attendance confirmation from Part One of the Banff & Lake Louise Ambassador Program. It was emailed to you at the address you provided on the date you attended Part One. The email also contained the Promo code needed to book your tour.
- o Personal identification

#### How Do I Book?

You will need the promo code that you received within your Part One attendance confirmation email. It was sent to you from the Banff & Lake Louise Ambassador Program on the date you attended Part One. Included in the tour is a ride to the top of Sulphur Mountain on the incredible Banff Gondola and finish the tour with an amazing photo opportunity at Lake Minnewanka (Lake Cruise not included). (Banff Return Only)</p> <p>How Much Is it? \$10.00</p>

<p><b>What Else Should I Know?</b></p> <p>Remember to be on time for your tour experience. The little blue bus and guide will be there to pick you up at a local Banff hotel of your choosing between 8:15am and 8:30am. You must be there for 8:15am, if the bus arrives at your pick up point and you are not there they will leave without you, and you will miss out on this opportunity. Refunds will not be arranged.</p> <p>Upon pick up, you will need to show the guide your proof of employment in Banff National Park, Part One attendance confirmation email and personal identification.</p>	<p><b>What Else Should I Know?</b></p> <p>You need to book your tour in advance, and we expect tours to be booked within 14 days of attending the Part One session. Tours run 7 days a week. Reservations are based on availability and while we do our best to accommodate your preferred date, demand can be high so please have alternate dates ready when booking.</p> <p>Remember to be on time for your tour experience. You need to be at the designated pick up location a minimum of 15 minutes before your departure time or they will leave without you, and you will miss out on this opportunity. Refunds will not be arranged.</p> <p>When boarding the coach you will need to show the guide your proof of employment in Banff National Park, Part One attendance confirmation email and personal identification.</p>
<p><b>How Do I Access the Part Three Ambassador Pass?</b></p> <p> <b>Discover Banff Tours</b></p> <p>Ambassador Program Participants are eligible to receive only one Ambassador Pass. Upon completion of both Part One and Part Two you are eligible to access Part Three of the Banff &amp; Lake Louise Ambassador Program. The Discover Banff Tours team at the store will check that you joined their Part Two tour.</p>	<p><b>How Do I Access the Part Three Ambassador Pass?</b></p> <p> <b>BREWSTER SIGHTSEEING</b></p> <p>Ambassador Program Participants are eligible to receive only one Ambassador Pass. Upon completion of both Part One and Part Two you are eligible to access Part Three of the Banff &amp; Lake Louise Ambassador Program.
